Post High School Achievements and Distinctions

Over 40 years enjoyed a successful career in business and government.

1955-1960; Production Manager, Board of Directors, Henkels & McCoy, Inc.

1960-1969; Corporate Vice President and Assistant to the Chairman, National Gypsum Company, Buffalo, NY; Vice President, Marketing, American Olean Tiles Company, Inc., wholly owned subsidiary of National Gypsum.

1969-1972; President and Chief Executive Officer, assumed Chairman of the Board in 1970, Simplex Wire and Cable Company, Boston, Massachusetts.

1970-1974; President and Chief Executive Officer of Snelling and Snelling, Inc. Brought in by largest shareholder to reorganize and turn around downward trend. Results were successful and documented by annual reports.

1971-1981; He was a Trustee of the Reading Company.

1974 saw him as a Candidate for Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

1975 he became a principal of Lewis and Associates.

Appointed as nation's seventh Secretary of Transportation by President Ronald W.

Reagan on December 11, 1980 and sworn into Cabinet on January 23, 1981.

He served two years as a member of the President's Cabinet.

1983-1986; he became Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Warner Amex Cable Communications, Inc., a partnership of Warner Communications and American Express.

He began a new job in 1986 as Chairman and CEO of the Union Pacific Railroad.

On April 1, 1987 he became President and Chief Operating Officer of the railroad's New York -based parent company, Union Pacific Corporation. He remained at Union Pacific until his retirement on December 31, 1996.
